Improve student academic achievement and eliminate the opportunity gap.

- Fix the teacher shortage by attracting and retaining highly-skilled professionals.
- Provide teacher and principal professional development, growth and evaluation.

Fully fund education to meet constitutional requirements per McCleary.

- Make material progress toward funding ESHB 2261/SHB 2776 requirements.
- Retain local levies for non-basic education purposes. Do no harm: local levies and Local Effort Assistance (LEA) are on a path for reduction. Reductions cannot take place until state funding is ample and equitable.
- Fund full-cost basic education compensation expenses.
 - Align* state funding of public school employee compensation with true cost.
 - Change* the current state salaries and benefits linked to basic education.
 - Take action* on the final report submitted by the Compensation Technical Working Group (June 2012) to ensure the state meets its responsibility to establish an equitable and adequate allocation system for public school employee compensation.
- Retain local bargaining over locally controlled non-basic education activities.

Pass a constitutional amendment to the people authorizing school district bond issues be approved with a simple majority vote.

Increase school construction funding.

- Ensure the state is amply funding the actual cost of constructing facilities necessary to reduce class sizes and fully implement all-day kindergarten.

Reform state revenue to address constitutional requirements per McCleary.

- Create a more equitable and fair state tax structure through tax reform to lessen property tax-based inequities.
